- 1). Town Hall Outdoor Lighting Update-** Yoder Electric was back at Town Hall this morning checking on the recently installed LED exterior light fixtures around Town Hall. They are currently functioning properly, however, they seem to be more prone to tripping the breaker which we will continue to monitor.
- 2). Solar Powered Pedestrian Crossing Update-** The Street Dept. has poured and fastened the bases for the pedestrian flashers along SR 37 at Arbor and Hawthorne Drives. Weather permitting the flashers will be up before Spring Break.
- 3). Plastic Lane Dividers on SR36/37-** Replacement lane dividers (35) were installed in front of the right in right out entrance of Kroger's (in front of BST&G Fire Station).
- 4). Street Sweeping Update-** As a follow-up to an inquiry made at a previous Services meeting, Brad Gerwig has obtained information on contracting out vs. purchasing and performing street sweeping in-house. There are two local (Columbus) firms that have provided quotes. We will need to discuss locations and frequency of sweeping (seasonal) before obtaining specific quotes.
