

Council Report

June 16, 2021

Planning the Police Impound Auction on Wednesday July 28th, 2021, at 5:00pm. If that date does not work (**We are waiting on car titles to be returned to us**) the backup date will be August 11th at the same time

Equipment needed:

5 New Radios (additional not replacement) **\$12,817.00** out of Impact funds.

4 New Patrol Rifles and the cost is unknown but estimated total cost would be around **\$3,000.00** (Impact funds) and these will take 120 days before we would receive them.

6 New Glock 22 .40 caliber handguns needed for new hires. **\$2,454.00** We need a few on hand in the event one or more issued firearms would need serviced. We are also replacing 4 firearms that were purchased by retired officers. (Chief Bennet, Detective Foley, Sgt. Landis, and Officer Norris) After we place the order these will take 90 days to get to us.

We have Officers completing their field training in the next few weeks and would encourage any council members willing to do a ride along to get ahold of Sgt. Meacham or myself to get your availability and set something up.

We are still working on some scenarios for joint training with the Police Department and Council members (let's not forget the mayor) and would like to get this completed by August 1st. We will need to know who all is interested in participating so we can plan accordingly.

Cases that Detective Smith is currently working on or has closed out in 2021

- 01) Public Employee charged with Dereliction of Duty and Forgery and prosecutor reduced to falsification and the trial is set for 06-15-21. (Closed pending outcome of trial)
- 02) Misuse of credit card stolen at the Sunbury Goodwill (Solved warrant Issued)
- 03) Stolen Trailer (Solved value was \$8,000 warrant issued for suspect).
- 04) Stolen vehicle from storage unit (Pending case)
- 05) Bank Robbery (2017) at Middlefield Bank Sunbury, Chase Bank in Columbus and US Bank in Morrow County **solved**. (Suspect(s) out of Cleveland area)
- 06) 2 cases of aggravated possession of drugs. (Closed)
- 07) Theft from local retailer (Pending case)
- 08) Theft, Breaking and entering at Big Walnut Baseball Association (Pending but solved)
- 09) Theft of Catalytic Converters from Eagle Auto and Little Buckeye Learning Center as well as a residence at the Sunbury Park apartments. a week prior that was not reported when it happened. (Pending)

Calls for service:

From May 1st to June 15th, 2021 we had **443** calls for service. I have attached a call log to this report, so you can see the breakdown of those calls.

We had **345** calls for service during the same time period in **2020 (98 more calls now as Covid restrictions are relaxing, and the public is more active)**

Court (Traffic):

Mayors Court: **22** Defendants with a total of **22** charges

Municipal Court: **4** Defendants with a total of **4** charges

Juvenile Court: **4** Defendants with a total of **4** charges

Criminal Citations: **6** Defendants with a total of **6** charges Mayors Court

Total Traffic stops for this time frame were **101**

Total Defendants cited were **32**

Roughly 68.5% of the vehicles stopped were issued either written or verbal warnings for their infractions.

The Police Department impounded **4** vehicles from **05-01 to 06-15**.
