

ORDINANCE NO. 2021.27

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SALE OF
UNNEEDED, OBSOLETE OR UNFIT PERSONAL PROPERTY AT PUBLIC AUCTION
PURSUANT TO OHIO REVISED CODE SECTION 721.15 AND DECLARING AN
EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the Village of Sunbury has personal property which is unneeded, obsolete or unfit for municipal purposes; and

WHEREAS, the estimated value of said personal property is \$1,000 or more; and

WHEREAS, Council wishes to authorize the sale of said personal property to the highest and best bidder after advertisement pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 721.15

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council for the Village Of Sunbury, Delaware County, State of Ohio, as follows:

SECTION 1: Council hereby authorizes the sale of personal property, the estimated value of which is \$1,000 or more pursuant to the Ohio Revised Code Section 721.15. A list of said personal property is as follows:

SECTION III: This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the Village of Sunbury, Ohio, to allow said auction to occur at the earliest possible date and thus create needed space for storage of future items as required in the policing of the Village of Sunbury.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after tis passage.
