

ORDINANCE 2021.36

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE EMPLOYMENT OF A DIRECTOR OF LAW

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council for the Village of Sunbury, Delaware County, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION I: Legal counsel shall be provided for this Village, and the person employed to such counsel shall be known as "Director of Law" of Sunbury, Ohio. Such Director of Law shall be employed by Council for a period not exceeding three years.

SECTION II: The annual retainer for the Director of Law shall be paid as follows:

1. One Hundred Thirty Thousand and 00/100 (\$130,000) Dollars the first year, payable in installments of Ten Thousand Eight Hundred Thirty Three and 33/100 (\$10,833.33) Dollars per month.
2. One Hundred Thirty-Three Thousand Nine Hundred and 00/100 (\$133,900) Dollars the second year, payable in installments of Eleven Thousand One Hundred Fifty Eight and 33/100 (\$11,158.33) Dollars per month.
3. One Hundred Thirty-Seven Thousand Nine Hundred Seventeen and 00/100 (\$137,917) Dollars the third year, payable in installments of Eleven Thousand Four Hundred Ninety Three and 08/100 (\$11,493.08) Dollars per month.

Said sum shall serve as compensation for services according to and pursuant to the attached Job Description, which is incorporated herein as if fully rewritten. All formal litigation services (when a lawsuit is filed of record) on behalf of the Village and Mayor's Court prosecutorial representation (in excess of 4 hours every 2 weeks) will be compensated at the rate of One Hundred Eighty-Seven and 75/100 (\$187.50) Dollars per hour, billed, except as otherwise indicated, for outside counsel per the attached exhibit.

SECTION III: The Director of Law shall be an attorney-at-law, admitted to practice in the Courts of Ohio. It shall be the duty of the Director of Law to act as attorney and counsel for the Village and the officers thereof in their official capacity, and, as such attorney, to prosecute and defend all actions by and against the Village or any department or officer thereof during the term of his employment, and to render legal opinions to the council and to any department or officer of the Village upon request.

SECTION IV: That David J. Brehm, Attorney at Law, be retained to serve as Director of Law for the Village of Sunbury, commencing September 3, 2021 for a period of three (3) years.

SECTION V: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and related to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in open meetings of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in

such formal action were meetings open to the public, and in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest time permitted by law.
