

ORDINANCE 2023.05

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF A 2022 PIPEHUNTER NON-CDL MINI COMBO TRUCK AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, there exists a continuing need within the Wastewater Treatment Department for a reliable PipeHunter vacuum truck for use in various City operations; and

WHEREAS, the current vacuum truck purchased has been in service for eighteen years and is no longer dependable; and

WHEREAS, Council has determined that the existing vacuum truck should be replaced; and

WHEREAS, a suitable 2022 PipeHunter Non-CDL Mini Combo Truck with 6" vacuum system was found at MTech Company in Cleveland, Ohio; and

WHEREAS, Article IX, paragraph 9.02 (C) of the Sunbury Charter allows Council by a majority vote of at least five (5) of its members to waive competitive bidding on a project provided Council determines that a waiver of the competitive bidding requirement is in the best interest of the Municipality; and

WHEREAS, Council accordingly hereby finds that the waiver of competitive bidding and the timely purchase of a replacement 2022 PipeHunter Non-CDL Mini Combo Truck with 6" vacuum system would in the best interests of Sunbury; and

WHEREAS, Sunbury Council wishes to authorize the purchase of said PipeHunter truck and to authorize the City Administrator to purchase said bucket truck and to execute any and all documentation necessary to effectuate said purchase.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Sunbury, Delaware County, Ohio.

SECTION I: Council hereby authorizes the purchase of a 2022 PipeHunter Non-CDL Mini Combo Truck with 6" vacuum system from MTech Company located in Cleveland, Ohio at a sum not to exceed Two Hundred Seventy Five Thousand (\$275,000.00) Dollars.

SECTION II: The City Administrator is hereby authorized to execute any and all necessary documents to effectuate said purchase.

SECTION III: Council expressly finds that the waiver of competitive bidding on the 2022 PipeHunter Non-CDL Mini Combo Truck with 6" vacuum system is in the best interest of the Municipality pursuant to Article IX, paragraph 9.02 (C) of the Sunbury Charter.

SECTION IV: It is found and determined that all former actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were meetings open to the public, and in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION V: This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the City of Sunbury, Ohio, to allow said PipeHunter truck to be purchased and placed into service at the earliest possible date to allow necessary projects to be completed without interruptions in service.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall be in effect and in force immediately from and after its passage.
