

ORDINANCE NO. 2023.04

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF A CRACK PRO 125 DA CRACK SEALING MACHINE OUTFITTED WITH ATTACHMENTS AND FURTHER AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF ALL DOCUMENTS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Sunbury, specifically the City Maintenance Department, needs a new crack sealing machine with attachments for street maintenance and other municipal purposes; and

WHEREAS, despite supply chain constraints and rising pricing associated with the Covid-19 pandemic, a suitable Crack Pro 125 DA crack sealing machine outfitted with attachments has been identified from ThorWorks Industries, Sandusky, Ohio which will fill the needs of the City; and

WHEREAS, the City of Sunbury wishes to authorize the purchase of said Crack Pro 125 DA outfitted with attachments for a sum not to exceed Seventy-Four Thousand One Hundred Thirty-Six and 24/100 dollars (\$74,136.42) from ThorWorks Industries in Sandusky, Ohio and to further authorize either the City Administrator or his designee to execute any documentation necessary to complete said purchase; and

WHEREAS, due to observed supply chain constraints and rising pricing associated with the Covid-19 pandemic, Council wishes to waive competitive bidding as being in the best interests of the municipality per the Sunbury Charter Article IV paragraph 9.02 (C).

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council for the City of Sunbury, Delaware County, State of Ohio, as follows:

SECTION I: Council hereby authorizes the purchase of a Crack Pro 125 DA outfitted with attachments for a sum not to exceed Seventy-Four Thousand One Hundred Thirty-Six and 24/100 dollars (\$74,136.42) from ThorWorks Industries in Sandusky, Ohio.

SECTION II: The City Administrator or his designee is hereby authorized to execute any and all necessary documents to purchase said Ventrac tractor with attachments.

SECTION III: Due to observed supply chain constraints and rising pricing associated with the Covid-19 pandemic, Council hereby waives competitive bidding as being in the best interests of the municipality per the Sunbury Charter Article IV paragraph 9.02 (C).

SECTION IV: It is found and determined that all former actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were meetings open to the public, and in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION V: This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of
