

ORDINANCE NO. 2023.06

**AN ORDINANCE AWARDDING THE CONTRACT FOR THE DEMOLITION OF
63 SOUTH COLUMBUS STREET AND 75 SOUTH COLUMBUS STREET TO
DILLEY’S EXCAVATING AND DEMO, LLC
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, on or about February 10, 2023, bids were solicited for the demolition of 63 South Columbus Street and 75 South Columbus Street ; and

WHEREAS, Dilley’s Excavating and Demo, LLC, Circleville, Ohio submitted the lowest and best bid of Twenty Five Thousand Five Hundred (\$25,500) Dollars for the base bid; and

WHEREAS, Sunbury City Council now wishes to determine that the bid of Dilley’s Excavating and Demo, LLC is the lowest and best bid and authorize the City Administrator to execute a contract and any other necessary documents to effectuate the award of the City of Sunbury demolition of 63 South Columbus Street and 75 South Columbus Street project to Dilley’s Excavating and Demo, LLC.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Sunbury, Delaware County, Ohio;

SECTION I: The contract for the City of Sunbury demolition of 63 South Columbus Street and 75 South Columbus Street is hereby awarded to Dilley’s Excavating and Demo, LLC pursuant to their lowest and best bid in the amount of Twenty Five Thousand Five Hundred (\$25,500) Dollars.

SECTION II: The City Administrator or alternatively, the Assistant City Administrator, is hereby authorized to execute a contract and any and all other necessary documents with Dilley’s Excavating and Demo, LLC to effectuate the award of said project.

SECTION III: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and related to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in open meetings of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were meetings open to the public, and in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION IV: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Sunbury, Ohio, to allow contract award and completion of the demolition work within grant deadlines and to promote public safety in light of the condition of the structures to be demolished.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately from and after its passage.
