

# Police Report Council Meeting July 19, 2023

**01: Drone:** D.C. Wade can update as the potential pilots are all in the beginning stages of the process and have 3 months to obtain the 107 (we are about 30 days in)

**02: Silverado trucks upfitting:** We received a call from PAR public safety, and they let us know that the equipment we are waiting on to upfit the trucks is scheduled to start arriving this week. They said the first shipment should arrive tomorrow, Thursday July 20<sup>th</sup>, and the trucks should be scheduled in within the next 2 weeks to begin installing the equipment.

**03: ESchedule:** The program is built but we are having issues with the coding portion of the program, and they are working those bugs out now. This last issue is just getting ESchedule to communicate with our current CMI program.
